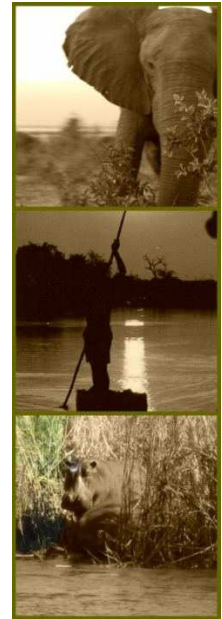
7days/ 6 nights

Incorporating:

3 night in the Okavango Delta, 3 nights Moremi Game Reserve Khwai region

Trip Summary

- Day 1 Pick up **Maun** meet the SGS Africa Team and drive to the **Okavango Delta** overnight camping
- Day 2 Explore the **Okavango Delta/Moremi Game Reserve** overnight camping
- Day 3 Explore the **Okavango Delta/Moremi Game Reserve** overnight camping
- Day 4 Drive from the Delta area to **Moremi Game Reserve Khwai** region overnight camping
- Day 5 Explore **Moremi Khwai** 4x4 game drives overnight camping
- Day 6 Explore **Moremi Khwai** 4x4 game drives overnight camping
- Day 7 Transfer road from Khwai back to Maun for onward arrangements(4 hour drive)



Safari itinerary cost:

Rate Morula Level camping with full day mokoro: US\$ 2628 per person sharing

Rate Mopane Level camping with full day mokoro: US\$ 2082 per person sharing

All itineraries can be adjusted to your specifications

Rate valid from 1st May 2010 until April 2012

Start Maun. End Maun .

Clients must be available for pick up in Maun before midday.

Transport: open 4 x4, light aircraft

Accommodation: camping. Min 2 people

Activities:4x4 Game Drives/mokoro option boat cruise

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Okavango Delta Day 1-3 (FI):

On Day 1 you will be met in Maun by your SGS Africa guide and driven into the Okavango Delta/Moremi Game Reserve to your private camp site. Here you can freshen up and enjoy a light lunch or tea before heading out on a game drive to explore this great wildlife area. On Day 2 an early wake up call is followed by light continental breakfast before your game drive. During the heat of the day you can have a light lunch and siesta in camp before an afternoon game drive or optional boat cruise. (additional cost). You will return early evening after a sundowner to a camp fire and delicious meal under the stars. On Day 3 there is a full day mokoro trip through the channels of the Delta with a packed lunch. This is the best way to experience the unique tranquility of the Delta. This part of Okavango is typical wetland and the scenery varies from grassy flood plains dotted with large termite mounds to well developed mopane forests and riverine woodland; from meandering streams to large open lagoons; from small islands fringed with palms to larger islands with forests of sausage and ebony trees. The Okavango Delta's beauty is beyond compare.



Moremi Game Reserve/Khwai region Day 4-6 (FI):

On Day 4 you will drive to Khwai area of Moremi Game Reserve. Once in this famous area of the reserve you can enjoy game drives in your open game drive vehicle. Days 5 and 6 can be spent exploring the surroundings and look for small and larger game species. Moremi is the protected extension of the Okavango Delta and offers a typical wetland system with grassy plains and pans surrounded by well-developed mopane forests and riverine woodland. Khwai is well known for great game sightings and beautiful scenery especially along the Khwai river. Huge breeding herds of elephant are common as are lechwe, waterbuck, impala, hippos. One can also hope to see buffalo, giraffe, bushbuck, lion, wild dog, leopard, cheetah, black-backed and side-striped jackal, zebra, wildebeest, tsessebe, bush babies, fruit bats, sable, kudu, roan, steenbok, duiker, honey badger. The birdlife includes water birds as well as dry land birds.

Day 7

On day 7 you will be driven back to Maun to connect with your onward travel Arrangements (Approximately 4 hour drive)

- Medium-sized walk-in tents (3 x 3 m) with built-in floors, mosquito gauze on two door and two windows
- Small shaded front verandah with door mats and chairs
- Beds with thin (100 mm / 4 in) mattresses (in a bedroll to keep bedding dust proof when moving camp)
- Full linen (one pillow & pillow case; sheets, duvet, duvet cover and two extra blankets; bath and hand towels & face cloth)
- Toiletries: (soap, toilet paper, mosquito repellent, mirror)
- Bedside tables, lamps, waste bin, floor mats
- Extras: flash lights & batteries, game drive blankets in winter
- laundry
- En suite shower (private portable shower, filled on request with hot water by camp staff)
- En suite bush toilet (toilet seat over a pre-dug pit with sand to fill in as you go)
- Wash stand – one for each person outside each tent - filled with hot water every morning and on request
- Dining table & chairs, serving table, waiter
- Tableware: table cloths & napkins, earthenware crockery, cutlery
- Bar: wine glasses & tumblers; full cold bar (bottled water, selection of soft drinks, mixers and juice, beer, red or white wine at dinner - as per client request)
- Healthy & hearty 3 course meals throughout
- Experienced licensed guide
- staff complement to take care of all camp chores
- Staff travel in separate back-up vehicle(s) in order to go ahead and set up camp for guests
- Guests do not get involved in any of the camp chores as everything is laid on for them
- Open game drive vehicles with shade roof, game viewing seats & long range fuel tanks
- Seat 6-10 pax (3 per seat) plus driver/guide
- Luggage space is restricted to approx 15 kg per person on game drive vehicles as well as on charter planes

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Included Mopane Level Camping:

- 4x4 game drives
- Walk-in tents (2,5 x 2,5 m) with built-in floors, mosquito gauze on door and windows
- Small shaded front verandah with door mats
- Camp beds with thin (80 mm / 3 in) mattresses (in a bedroll to keep bedding dust proof when moving camp)
- Full linen (1 pillow, pillow case, sheets, duvet, duvet cover, towels & 1 x light extra blanket)
- Toiletries: (toilet paper only)
- **Shared shower (private portable shower filled on request with hot water by camp staff) or shower in public camp site**
- **Shared bush toilet (toilet seat over a pre-dug pit with ash to fill in as you go) or toilets in public camp sites**
- Wash stands outside tent - one per tent - filled with hot water every morning
- Gazebo – used at the discretion of the staff to provide shade & protection from the wind & rain
- Dining table & stools
- Tableware: table cloths & paper napkins, durable melamine crockery, cutlery
- Two course meals throughout
- **Limited Bar: filtered/bottled water, boxed wine & cordials (we can take clients to a shop to purchase additional drinks before we depart on safari)**
- Experienced licensed guide
- Limited staff complement to help with camp chores
- **Staff may travel with guests in same vehicle**
- Guests could be asked to assist the guide or staff with occasional camp chores such as collecting firewood or water, packing up camp, etc

- Seat 10 pax (3 per seat) plus driver/guide
- Game drive vehicle pulls trailer with all camping equipment
