

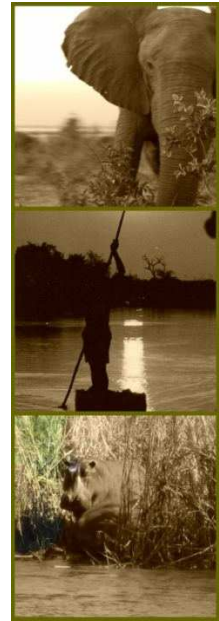


**The Best of the Chobe

Trip Summary

- Day 1 Pick up Kasane, meet **SGS Africa team** and drive into **Chobe National Park**
overnight camping
- Day 2 Explore **Chobe-PM Chobe boat cruise**
overnight camping
- Day 3 Drive from Chobe to **Savute**
(Approx 5 hours drive) overnight camping
- Day 4 Explore **Savute**
overnight camping
- Day 5 Light aircraft flight from Savute into the **Okavango Delta**
overnight permanent camp
- Day 6 Explore the **Okavango Delta** by mokoro, boat and on foot
overnight permanent camp
- Day 7 Explore the **Okavango Delta** by mokoro, boat and on foot
overnight permanent camp
- Day 8 Transfer to Maun by light aircraft for your onward travel arrangements



Itinerary available at all our camping levels

Start Kasane End Maun. This trip can run both directions.
If starting in Maun clients must be available for pick up before 1pm.
Transport: open 4x4, light aircraft (planes may stop twice on their routes)
Accommodation: camping, permanent camp
Activities: Walking, birding, mokoros, boats, game drives

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Chobe National Park Day 1-2 (FI)

Meet the SGS Africa team in the morning and drive into Chobe National Park to your private camp site. Enjoy a cold drink and packed lunch on the way. When you arrive, freshen up and then explore your new surroundings and enjoy a sundowner by the Chobe river. (At Mopane and Acacia Levels all the camp staff travel with guests in game viewing vehicle which pulls a trailer with all camping equipment and luggage) On Day 2 explore Chobe's beautiful waterfront and valleys. An early wake up call with a continental breakfast before your morning drive followed by brunch and then an afternoon boat cruise on the Chobe River. After the boat you will game drive back to camp for a bush shower and dinner under the stars. All activities are flexible depending on what you may see in the bush. Along the Chobe riverfront the terrain is that of a typical riverine ecosystem. Away from the river we have mixed miombo and broadleaved woodland that harbours rich avifauna. Northern Chobe is famous for its huge elephant & buffalo herds, puku, kudu, Chobe bushbuck and hippo as well as diverse bird life. One could also hope to see: lion, leopard, wild dog, giraffe, waterbuck, zebra, impala.



Savute Days 3-4 (FI):

On Day 3 an early start to break camp and drive to Savute. While the back up team pack up enjoy a short game drive in Chobe before meeting up and driving on convoy to Savute. This is about a 5 hour drive through community areas and National Park. You stop for a packed lunch on the way. (At Mopane and Acacia Levels all the camp staff travel with guests in game viewing vehicle which pulls a trailer with all camping equipment and luggage) After freshening up at your new campsite you can go on a game drive to explore your surroundings. On Day 4 you have a whole day to explore Savute. An early start in the morning with a break in camp during the heat of the day for lunch and a rest, then back out in the afternoon ensures the best chances of seeing plentiful game before enjoying a hot bush shower and dinner under the stars. The Marsh in Savute is typical grassland surrounded by Acacia bush and stony outcrops. Savute is famous for its lone elephant bulls, its lions and hyaenas as well as the zebra and wildebeest migrations. Other game one can hope to see include: giraffe, tsessebe, warthog, black-backed jackal, leopard, cheetah, bat-eared fox, impala, wild dog, kudu.

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Gunns Camp/Moremi Crossing in the Okavango Delta Days 5-7 (FI)

On Day 5 you will be taken to the airstrip in Savute where you will say goodbye to the SGS Africa team and fly by light aircraft into the Okavango Delta. For Mopane/Acacia clients Moremi Crossing camp is a mid level permanent camp situated on a beautiful palm dotted island overlooking Chief's Island. Moremi Crossing offers guests a traditional safari experience with the emphasis on walking and water based activities including boats and mokoros. The camp focuses on guest comfort with simplicity. The main building consists of a large open plan deck offering magnificent views over the Boro River. The 16 tents are ensuite vintage style and dining is communal. For Morula/Ebony clients Gunns camp is a 6 tented luxury camp and the sister camp to Moremi Crossing. The tents are large and beautifully furnished, ensuite and in a truly magical setting. The camp focuses on expert guiding and offers mokoros, boat cruises, walks. Dining is also communal. This part of Okavango is typical wetland and the scenery varies from grassy flood plains dotted with large termite mounds to well developed mopane forests and riverine woodland; from meandering streams to large open lagoons; from small islands fringed with palms to larger islands with forests of sausage and ebony trees.
