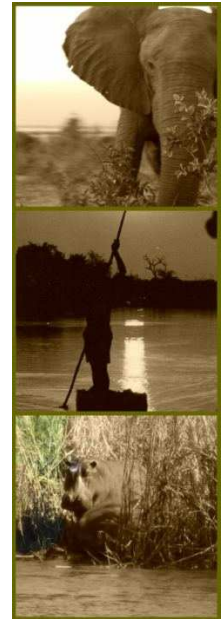
7days/ 6 nights

Trip Summary

- Day 1 Pick up **Maun** meet the SGS Africa Team and drive to the **Okavango Delta** overnight camping
- Day 2 Explore the **Okavango Delta game drives** overnight camping
- Day 3 Explore the **Okavango Delta game drives and PM boat cruise** overnight camping
- Day 4 Drive from the Delta area to **Moremi Game Reserve** Khwai region overnight camping
- Day 5 Explore **Moremi Khwai** 4x4 game drives and **PM mokoro trip** overnight camping
- Day 6 Explore **Moremi Khwai** 4x4 game drives overnight camping
- Day 7 Transfer road from Khwai back to Maun for onward arrangements(4 hour drive)

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Okavango Delta Day 1-3 (FI):

On Day 1 you will be met in Maun by your SGS Africa guide and driven into the Okavango Delta/Moremi Game Reserve to your private camp site. Here you can freshen up and enjoy a light lunch or tea before heading out on a game drive to explore this great wildlife area. (At Mopane and Acacia Levels all the camp staff travel with guests in game viewing vehicle which pulls a trailer with all camping equipment and luggage) On Day 2 and 3 an early wake up call is followed by light continental breakfast before your game drive. During the heat of the day you can have a light lunch and siesta in camp before an afternoon game drive or boat cruise. You will return early evening after a sundowner to a camp fire and delicious meal under the stars. This part of Okavango is typical wetland and the scenery varies from grassy flood plains dotted with large termite mounds to well developed mopane forests and riverine woodland; from meandering streams to large open lagoons; from small islands fringed with palms to larger islands with forests of sausage and ebony trees. The Okavango Delta's beauty is beyond compare.



Moremi Game Reserve/Khwai region Day 4-6 (FI):

On Day 4 you will drive to Khwai area of Moremi Game Reserve. Once in this famous area of the reserve you can enjoy game drives in your open game drive vehicle. (At Mopane and Acacia Levels all the camp staff travel with guests in game viewing vehicle which pulls a trailer with all camping equipment and luggage) Days 5 and 6 can be spent exploring the surroundings and look for small and larger game species on morning and afternoon game drives as well as a mokro trip through the channels of Sable Alley. Moremi is the protected extension of the Okavango Delta and offers a typical wetland system with grassy plains and pans surrounded by well-developed mopane forests and riverine woodland. Khwai is well known for great game sightings and beautiful scenery especially along the Khwai river. Huge breeding herds of elephant are common as are lechwe, waterbuck, impala, hippos. One can also hope to see buffalo, giraffe, bushbuck, lion, wild dog, leopard, cheetah, black-backed and side-striped jackal, zebra, wildebeest, tsessebe, bush babies, fruit bats, sable, kudu, roan, steenbok, duiker, honey badger. The birdlife includes water birds as well as dry land birds.

Day 7

On Day 7 you will be driven back to Maun to connect with your onward travel
